1. Front of House & Door Tool

Both box office and artist services will be hosted in The Ledward Centre this year. Opening hours will be 10-6 Monday – Saturday and 10-4 Sunday. Box Office will remain open until 6pm Sundays as well.

We have been regularly attending the local branch of Equity's meetings and have received some feedback regarding Fringe venues. They have asked if venues hosting theatre can produce cast lists and boards. You can also find out about joining Equity every Wednesday at The Ledward Centre.

Fringe-time Fringe Academy workshops now live including Future of Fringe (24 May 11am-12.30 at Rotunda), Networking at North Laine (Tuesday Evenings with a discount on drinks for all those with Fringe passes), and Life After Fringe Sessions. We would love to see more representation from VMs at these events so please do join us if you are able!

6. Survivor's Network

We recently received bystanders training from Survivor's Network, one of our charity partners for this year. If any venues would be interested in training their teams in how to intervene when witnessing sexual harrassment, please let Rhiannon know and we can put you in touch.

7. Feedback from The Chair

The Board Meeting to approve annual accounts takes place this evening (23.4.24) and rigorous stress testing of accounts up until September 2025 has taken place and been successful, ensuring a positive start for Brighton Fringe 2025.
